FINANCIAL COMMITMENT

Monetary Commitment:

\$350/player: Some teams may choose to raise a portion of the player fee by holding fundraisers. Any team that qualifies and chooses to go to a national tournament will require additional fees and/or fund raising.

Players will not receive their uniform until at least half of the tuition payment is made. In addition players may not be allowed to compete past the half way point of the tournament schedule until final payments are made.

Each team is required to participate in fundraising for the entire Titans organization by helping with Titans basketball tournaments and or other events.

What's included in the financial commitment?

- Approximately seven tournament fees
- AAU Individual Membership Fees
- Uniform and Shooting shirt
- Gym rental fees
- Discounts on Rusty LaRue Basketball Academy and Triad Titans player development programs
- Miscellaneous expenses (postage, basketball supplies, etc)
- Your son benefits from higher level coaching and competition. Triad Titans basketball coaches are not paid. They are volunteers that coach for their love of the game and their desire to be a positive influence in children's lives.

What's NOT included in the financial commitment?

- Traveling expenses: fees associated with traveling (e.g. gas, lodging, food, and other incidentals) to local, regional, and national tournaments.
- Team shoes or other team gear chosen on a team-by-team basis.
